## OPEN MEETINGS RESOLUTION

## 2017-2018

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) NMSA 1978 requires the Board of Education of the Cimarron Municipal School District, Cimarron, New Mexico (the "Board"), to determine what notice for a public meeting shall be reasonable, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of the regular meeting of the Board on March 18,2015 , at which the adoption of this Resolution is to be considered, has been given in accordance with the Open Meetings Resolution of the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that reasonable notice to the public of any meetings of the Board shall consist of:

1. As to any Regular Meeting, either:
(a) Public announcement at any previous meeting of the date, time, and place it is to be held, or
(b) Electronically posting a notice of the date, time, and place on the Cimarron Municipal Schools' web page www.cimarronschools.org at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting, or
(c) Distributing notice of the date, time, and place of the meeting to newspapers of general circulation within the school district, at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting, or
(d) Posting a notice in the Superintendent's office of the date, time, and place at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting, or
(e) Posting a notice of the date, time, and place in the main hallway of the school district administration building at least seventy-two (72) hours in advance of the meeting, or
(f) Posting the schedule of regular meetings of the Board to be held during the year will be posted in the main lobby of the school district's Administrative Building, 125 N. Collison Ave., Cimarron, New Mexico 87714.

All meetings shall be held once per month on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m., or as otherwise specified by the Board. The location will be alternately every other month Cimarron Elementary/Middle Schools Board Meeting Room and Eagle Nest Elementary/Middle Schools Board Meeting Room, or as otherwise specified by the Board. The notice of regular meetings shall include an agenda which contains a list of specific items of business to be discussed or transacted or information on how the public may obtain a copy of such an agenda which agenda will ordinarily be available at
the Superintendent's office and on the Cimarron Municipal Schools' web page. Except in the case of an emergency, the agenda will be available to the public at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting. Except for emergency matters, the Board will take action only on items that have been officially posted on the final agenda at least thirty-six (36) hours prior to the meeting in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.
2. As to any Special Meeting, either:
(a) Public announcement of the date, time, and place of such meeting at any regular or special meeting held at least three (3) days before the commencement of the special meeting so announced, or
(b) Electronically posting a notice of the date, time, and place on the Cimarron Municipal Schools' web page www.cimarronschools.org at least three (3) days in advance of the meeting, or
(c) Distributing notice of the date, time, and place of the meeting to local television stations, radio stations and newspapers of general circulation within the school district, at least ten (3) days in advance of the meeting, or
(d) Posting a notice of the date, time, and place in the Superintendent's office at least three (3) days in advance of the meeting, or
(e) Posting a notice of the date, time, and place in the main lobby of the district's administration building at least three (3) days in advance of the meeting.

The notice of special meetings shall include an agenda which contains a list of specific items of business to be discussed or transacted or information on how the public may obtain a copy of such an agenda which will ordinarily be available at the Superintendent's office and on the Cimarron Municipal Schools' web page. Except in the case of an emergency, the agenda will be available to the public at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting. Except for emergency matters, the Board will take action only on items that have been officially posted on the final agenda at least thirty-six (36) hours prior to the meeting in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.
3. As to any Emergency Meeting, either:
(a) Distribution notice of the date, time, and place of the meeting to local television stations, radio stations and newspapers of general circulation, at least thirty-six (36) hours in advance of the meeting, or
(b) Electronically posting a notice on the Cimarron Municipal Schools' web page www.cimarronschools.org at least thirty-six (36) hours in advance of the meeting.
(c) If thirty-six (36) hours notice is not possible, as much notice as is practical under the circumstances will be given in accordance with paragraphs 3(a) and (b).

The notice of emergency meetings shall include an agenda which contains a list of specific items of business to be discussed or transacted, or information on how the public may obtain a copy of such an agenda.

Emergency meetings are those meetings necessitated by circumstances which require immediate action to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the students and employees of the district, to protect the property of the district or to avoid substantial financial loss to the district. Within ten (10) days of taking action on an emergency matter, the district shall report to the Attorney General's Office the action taken and the circumstances creating the emergency; provided that no report to the Attorney General is required if a state or national emergency has been declared. Emergency meetings may be called by the President of the Board or by a majority of the members of the Board.
4. As to any Closed Meeting, either:
(a) By adoption of a motion in an open meeting by vote of a majority of the quorum there present, which motion shall state with reasonable specificity the subject to be discussed and the authority for such closure and roll call vote of the members present recorded in the minutes of such open meeting, or
(b) If a closed meeting is to be held other than pursuant to motion and vote as set out in subparagraph (a) above, reasonable notice thereof shall be given pursuant to the requirements of Paragraph 2 above dealing with notice of special meetings.
(c) Any notice of a closed meeting as well as any motion adopted for a closed meeting shall, in addition to other requirements herein set forth, include the following:
(i) identification of the specific authority permitting such closed meeting pursuant to Section 10-15-1(H)(1).
(ii) if the meeting is to be closed as a "limited personnel matter" pursuant to Section $10-15-1(\mathrm{H})(2)$, the notice shall also specifically set forth whether said meeting is for the purposes of discussion of hiring, promotion, demotion, dismissal, assignment, or resignation or of the investigation or consideration of complaints or charges against any individual public employee, provided that the name of the individual shall not be disclosed.
(iii) if the authority for closure of the meeting is pursuant to an "administrative adjudicatory proceeding" pursuant to Section $10-15-1(\mathrm{H})(3)$, the notice shall include the caption or title of the proceeding.
(iv) if the authority for closure of the meeting is pursuant to Section $10-15-1(\mathrm{H})(4)$ relating to personally identifiable information about an individual student, the notice will identify that the meeting relates to a matter affecting a student without further personal identification.
(v) if the authority for closure of the meeting is pursuant to the collective bargaining negotiations, pursuant to Section $10-15-1(\mathrm{H})(5)$, said notice shall identify the contract which is the subject matter of the negotiations and the bargaining unit with whom the district is negotiating.
(vi) if the authority for closure of the meetings concern purchases pursuant to Section 10-15-1(E)(6) or for the purpose of discussion of purchase or acquisition of real property or water rights pursuant to Section $10-15-1(\mathrm{H})(8)$, the notice shall provide a general description of the purchase contemplated.
(vii) in the event the authority for closure of the meeting is to discuss matters subject to the attorney-client privilege pertaining to threatened or pending litigation in which the public body is or may become a participant pursuant to Section 10-$15-1(H)(7)$, then the caption of the pending litigation shall be disclosed in the notice.
(viii) following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open meeting that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting if the closed meeting was separately scheduled, shall state that the matters discussed in the closed meeting were limited only to those specified in the motion for closure or in the notice of the separate closed meeting.
5. The live broadcast of any general, special, or emergency meeting, by means of any television or radio facility which regularly broadcasts in the school district shall be permitted.
6. Participation by a member of the Board in a meeting by conference telephone or other similar equipment is permissible when it is otherwise difficult or impossible for the member to attend the meeting in person, provided that each Board member participating by conference telephone can be identified when speaking, all participants are able to hear each other at the same time and members of the public attending the meeting are able to hear any member of the Board who speaks during the meeting.
7. The Board may recess and reconvene a meeting to a day subsequent to that stated in the meeting notice if, prior to recessing, the Board specifies the date, time, and place for continuation of the meeting and, immediately following the recessed meeting, posts notice of the date, time, and place for the reconvened meeting on or near the door of the place where the original meeting was held and in the Board of Education office at 125 N. Collison Ave., Cimarron, New Mexico 87714. Only matters appearing on the agenda of the original meeting will be discussed at the reconvened meeting.
8. In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall include the following language:

If you are an individual with a disability who is in need of a reader, amplifier, qualified sign language interpreter, or any other form of auxiliary aid or service to attend or participate in the hearing or meeting, please contact the Board of Education office at least one week prior to the meeting or as soon as possible. Public documents, including the agenda and minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the Board of Education office (575) 376-2445 if a summary or other type of accessible format is needed.

IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED that substantial compliance with any one or more of the foregoing alternatives which may be applicable is reasonable notice, but this determination shall not be construed to prevent the use of additional means or methods of making known the date, time, and place of holding any public meeting, or other information with reference thereto, as may be directed from time to time by or under the authorization of the Superintendent. Further, this Resolution shall not be construed to require notice in instances where the same is not required by law.

All or part of this Resolution may be amended or modified by the Board from time to time.

If any provision or clause of this Resolution is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or clauses of this Resolution, which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or clauses, and to this end, the provisions and clauses of this resolution are declared to be severable.

Current and ongoing initiatives identified for this school year include installation of interactive projectors in all instructional spaces, rollout of two to three hundred more Chromebooks for the middle schools, redistribution of/or the best iPads to the lower grades to support iStation and iReady, implementation of a new hosted VOIP phone system, coordination and installation of new Meraki wireless through E-rate district wide, implementation of new switches for Eagle Nest and the high school, and facilitation and support of the construction and building consolidations in Cimarron.

STS will work at the discretion of CMSD management on other assignments and project per the approval of the Superintendent and Governing Council. If new initiatives arise, or if there are
significant increases in equipment, student enrollment, or other projects outside of the scope of this initial proposal, STS will help procure bids from partner organizations, or outside vendors, to complete the projects upon approval of the Superintendent.

## Pricing Estimate

All costs are based on the scope and assumptions included in this Statement of Work. Invoicing schedule not to exceed estimate total plus applicable gross receipts tax (GRT may change bi-annually): \$54,960 + \$4,018.95 (7.3125\% GRT) = \$58,978.95.

# PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY SERVICES 

THIS PROFESSIONAL AGREEMENT is hereby entered into by the Cimarron Municipal Schools, hereinafter referred to as DISTRICT and Rhonda Lee Hicks, hereinafter referred to as INDEPENDENT

## CONTRACTOR.

## 1. Scope of Services.

A. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall provide to the DISTRICT the scope of services described on Exhibit AA" [optional: describe scope of services here]. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall provide the DISTRICT all related and support services required to carry out the responsibilities and duties described herein.
B. The services completed herein must meet the approval of the DISTRICT and shall be subject to the DISTRICT'S general right of inspection and supervision to secure the satisfactory completion thereof. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all Federal, State, Municipal and DISTRICT laws, rules and regulations that are now, or may in the future become applicable to INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR'S business, equipment, and personnel engaged in operations covered by this Agreement or accruing out of the performance of such operations.
i. The DISTRICT shall monitor the work performance and compliance with policies, laws and regulations performed by the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, including its employees, at each school site. The DISTRICT may request in writing the removal of any employee of the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR who violates DISTRICT policies, procedures, directives or laws and regulations or conducts himself or herself in a manner that is detrimental to the well-being of the students, provided such request is not in violation of any federal, state or local employment laws. In the event of the removal or suspension of any such employee of the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall immediately provide a replacement employee without disruption of service.
ii. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, as well as its designated employees assigned to the DISTRICT pursuant to this Agreement, shall maintain student confidentiality consistent with all applicable laws, regulations, and DISTRICT policies, including, but not limited to, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act.
iii. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, including its employee and volunteers, with unsupervised access to students shall be required to undergo criminal background checks and obtain clearance from the DISTRICT prior to providing any services under this Agreement.
2. Compensation.
A. Subject to 2 B . and 2C., below, payments will be made by DISTRICT to INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR at a rate of $\$ 47.39$ per hour]. In no event shall the total amount paid as total compensation for services provided pursuant to this contract exceed $\$ 40,476.00$ without prior Board approval. Applicable gross receipts taxes shall be included in all statements billed under this Contract, but gross receipts tax shall be in addition to total compensation.
B. Invoices. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall provide to the DISTRICT single monthly billings with supporting invoices detailing the expenses incurred for which payment is requested and a description of the services performed. Each billing shall be certified correct by the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR as to time and services. If, within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of certified billing from the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR the DISTRICT finds that the services, construction or items of tangible personal property delivered by INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR are not acceptable, the DISTRICT will provide to the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR a letter of exception explaining the defect or objection along with details of how the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR may proceed to provide remedial action.

C. Payment. Payments to INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall be made by the DISTRICT on a monthly basis within fifteen (15) business days of DISTRICT's verification and approval of any billing from INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR as set forth herein. Payments made by mail shall be deemed tendered on the date such payment is post-marked.

## 3. Term of Contract.

A. The initial term of this contract shall commence on __August 21 st $\qquad$ , 20_17 $\qquad$ , and terminate at the close of the day on June 30, 20 $\qquad$ , provided that this Agreement may be renewed by the parties for up to $\qquad$ 1 $\qquad$ additional terms of 12 months each, if agreeable to both parties. This agreement may be terminated by either party after thirty (30) days written notice is given the other party to this agreement at any time, regardless of the term of the contract. By such termination, neither party may nullify obligations or liabilities for performance or failure to perform incurred prior to the date of termination.
B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph A, above, the terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient authorizations and appropriations being or having been made by the New Mexico State Legislature for performance of this Agreement in the fiscal year which begins July 1, 20 $\qquad$ and in succeeding fiscal years. If sufficient appropriations and authorizations are not made or have not been made by the New Mexico State Legislature in any fiscal year, this Agreement shall terminate upon seven (7) days written notice from DISTRICT to INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, provided that by such termination neither party may nullify obligations or liabilities for performance or failure to perform incurred prior to the date of termination. DISTRICT's decision as to whether sufficient authorizations and appropriations are or have been made in any fiscal year shall be final. Termination of this Agreement for lack of sufficient appropriations shall not constitute a termination for fault of the DISTRICT. The parties further agree that DISTRICT's sole obligation to pay, in the event this Agreement is terminated for lack of sufficient appropriations, is the obligation to pay INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR for work performed and approved for payment prior to notice of termination unless otherwise modified in writing by the parties.
4. Status of Independent Contractor. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, its agents and employees, are independent contractors performing services for the DISTRICT and are not employees of the DISTRICT. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, its agents and employees shall not accrue leave, retirement, insurance, or other benefits provided to DISTRICT employees as a result of this Agreement. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall furnish at his/her own expense, all labor, materials, equipment and other items necessary to carry out the terms of this Agreement.
5. Insurance. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall provide DISTRICT with a Certificate of Insurance showing a minimum $\$ 1,000,000$ combined single limits of general liability and automobile coverage's and/or Builder's Risk; worker's compensation and unemployment insurance in the amounts required by New Mexico law. The insurance coverage must be in full force and in effect during the agreement term and shall name the DISTRICT as an additional insured. The INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR must provide updated insurance certificates to the DISTRICT, all of which are attached hereto as Exhibit "C".
6. Indemnification. The INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall indemnify the Board, its individual members, officers, agents and employees from any and all liability, loss or damage including costs and attorneys fees, they, or any of them, may suffer or be subject to as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgments of parties other than the INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR against Board and DISTRICT, its individual members, officers, agents or employees arising out of INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR's performance of or failure to perform its duties or obligations under this Agreement, regardless of whether the liability, loss or damage is caused by, or arises out of, the negligence of INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, its individual officers, agents or employees or otherwise.
7. Assignment. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall not assign or transfer any interest in this Agreement or assign any claims for money due, or to become due, under this Agreement without the prior written approval of the DISTRICT.
8. Subcontracting. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall not subcontract any portion of the services to be performed under this Agreement without the prior written approval of the DISTRICT.
9. Records and Audits. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall maintain detailed time and expense records which indicate the date, time and nature of the services rendered to the DISTRICT, or expenses incurred on behalf of the DISTRICT and the DISTRICT shall, upon giving reasonable notice, have the right to review the records kept by INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR shall maintain such records for a period of at least three years following termination of this Agreement.
10. Conflict of Interest. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR warrants that it has no known current interest and does not anticipate that it will acquire any interest which directly or indirectly would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services under this Agreement.
11. Product of Service, Copyright. Nothing produced, in whole or in part, by INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall be the subject of an application for copyright by, or on behalf of, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, without the prior written approval of the Institute.
12. Amendment. Any material change in the terms of this Agreement shall be deemed an amendment, and any amendment shall be void unless made in writing and signed by both the parties.
13. Applicable Law. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Mexico. In the event any suit is brought to enforce this Agreement, venue shall be in $\qquad$ , New Mexico.
