# NOTICE OF SALE AUTHORIZATION

WHEREAS, at a general obligation bond election duly called and held for Cimarron Municipal School District No. 3, County of Colfax, State of New Mexico, (the "District") on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2014, the electors of the District authorized the Board of Education of the Cimarron Municipal School District No. 3 (the "Board"), to contract bonded indebtedness in the amount of \$7,000,000 on behalf of the District and upon the credit thereof by issuing general obligation bonds of the District;

WHEREAS, the Board has authorized the President of the Board and the Superintendent to issue a Notice of Sale of General Obligation Bonds and it is hereby determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the District and the inhabitants thereof that general obligation school building bonds authorized at the election on March 4, 2014 in the amount of \$3,000,000 be issued in accordance with this Notice of Sale; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the following Notice of Sale is issued as follows:

Section 1. The President of the Board and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to do all things necessary for the sale of the District's general obligation school building bonds, including submission of a loan application to the New Mexico Finance Authority, and by means of a negotiated sale should that be advantageous to the District.

Section 2. The President of the Board and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to determine the date, time and place to receive bids for sale of bonds authorized at the March 4, 2014 bond election, including the series, the dated date, the principal amount maturing in each year, maturity and interest payment dates, redemption provisions, and any other terms related to the bonds. The President of the Board and the Superintendent are hereby further authorized and directed to have published a notice of sale of authorized bonds, after determination of the details of the authorized bonds, in the Albuquerque Journal, or other newspaper of general and local circulation in the District, once, at least one week prior to the date of the sale. The President of the Board and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to give such other notice of the bond sale including the publication of the notice in financial papers and periodicals and the distribution among investment bankers and others of a Preliminary Official Statement relating to the bonds.

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# RESOLUTION

# AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND PROJECT APPROVAL TO THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Cimarron Municipal School District No. 3, County of Colfax, State of New Mexico, (the "District"), is a qualified entity under the New Mexico Finance Authority Act, NMSA 1978, §§ 6-21-1 through 6-21-31 ("Act"), and the Board of Education of the Cimarron Municipal School District No. 3, ("Board") is the governing body of the District and is authorized to borrow funds and/or issue bonds for the financing of public projects for the benefit of the District; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2017 Board adopted a Resolution Authorizing Notice of Sale of General Obligation Bonds in the amount of \$3,000,000, authorizing the sale of the remaining portion of \$7,000,000 of bonds authorized at a regular election held on March 4, 2014, for the purposes specified in Section 22-18-1 et seq. NMSA 1978; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Finance Authority ("NMFA") has instituted a program for the financing of projects from the public project revolving fund created under the Act and has developed an application procedure through which the Board may submit an application ("Application") for financial assistance for public projects from the NMFA with costs of financing and issuance that are generally lower than those associated with a public sale; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends to undertake the construction and renovation of school buildings, furnishing school buildings, and improvement of school grounds, and to provide matching funds for capital outlay projects funded pursuant to the Public School Capital Outlay Act, or any combination of these purposes ("Project") for the benefit of the District and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the District and its citizens to submit an application to the NMFA for financing of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the application required by the NMFA has been completed and submitted to the Board, and this resolution approving submission of the completed application to the NMFA for its consideration and review is required as part of the Application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CIMARRON MUNICIPAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 3, COUNTY OF COLFAX AND STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. That all action (not inconsistent with the provision hereof) heretofore taken by the Board, its officers and employees directed toward the Application and the Project, be and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

- Section 2. That the Application submitted to the Board, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed.
- Section 3. That the officers and employees of the Board are hereby directed and requested to submit the Application to the NMFA for its review, and are further authorized to take such other action as may be requested by the NMFA in its consideration and review of the Application and to further proceed with arrangements for financing the Project.
- Section 4. All acts and resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby rescinded, annulled and repealed.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

#### Eagle Nest Board Report for March 2017

My Teacher Advisory Committee spent a lot of time reflecting on children's attitudes, success, and causes at our last meeting. Of all the years doing this we always seem to get the same results, but we always want to check to be sure our direction is correct. Because of these yearly "checks" this is why Eagle Nest School is big on Character Education.

This year we wanted to go big on our research gathering. I asked four people the same question: what are the top three causes of failure among children? One person works at Eagle Nest, one teaches in New York City, one does financial business around the world, and the last individual works with an organization that has created a think tank with world leaders discussing how to prevent country/individual failure around the world.

#### Person A

- 1. Lack of teacher training
- 2. Need social emotional classes
- 3. ESL help, for example the schools need to teach phonics and basic reading skills beyond elementary grades.

#### Person B

- 1. No motivation among children
- 2. Lack of social skills
- 3. Anger issues

#### Person C

- 1. Unwillingness of parent to impress upon their children that the future is dependent on what they do today.
- 2. Kids need a mentor.
- 3. Striving is important everybody doesn't get a trophy.

#### Person D

- 1. Lack of resources at home and school.
- 2. Distractions at home
- 3. Lack of parental involvement

Wow, the themes practically knock you over. By the way our friends in rural Australia have the same issues as Cimarron School District. I want to tie this into what an ex dean from Stanford said every 18 year old must be able to do.

An 18 year old must be able to talk to strangers, must be able to find his way around, must be able to manage his assignments, workload, and deadlines. An 18 year old must be able to contribute to the running of a household, must be able to handle, interpersonal problems, must be able to cope with ups and downs, must be able to earn and manage money, and finally an 18 year old must be able to take risks.

Now you can see how all this leads into our Character Education, which focuses on, Zest, Grit, Self Control school work, Self control interpersonal, Optimism, Gratitude, Social Intelligence, and Curiosity. Yes, you are correct these are things that are taught in the home. Unfortunately some of our children do not have an adult in the home that teaches the above. This is why Eagle Nest strives for all these "different" ideas. These different ideas allow our children to grow in these special areas, and for our children who already have these concepts given to them by the home it just allows for advancement.

As you know Eagle Nest School is blessed with a great community that supports education, this allows many wonderful things to happen. Two accomplishments are: one it allows us to expand our curriculum for free (Important words for education now!) and two it gives us an opportunity for our children to learn and /or expand the above concepts. Let me share a wonderful examples with you.

Mr. Waggoner created a class this year called Snow Sport Industry Exploration. He takes his group to the Resort every Thursday at noon. They have learned various components of the ski industry: accounting, personal, lift operations, snow grooming, and the list goes on and on. Yesterday Mr. Waggoner took 14 elementary children, many of which have never skied, to the resort to have his group of mid school children teach them how to ski. These activities, for both age groups, teach the above concepts. A nice side is that this class will make our students better employees for Angel Fire Resort. Check out these pictures!
