Registration for School

- Registration must be completed for each student.
- Online: Go to www.cimarronschools.org, click on your child's school on the menu bar and follow the links to complete online registration.
- Paper: Pick up a paper version of the packet at the school office
- The School Lunch Program application needs to be completed separately in a paper version which you can pick up from the school office

What to Expect as We Start School

- Remote Learning PreK to 12th grade August 12-14
- Cimarron Schools will begin Remote Learning. All students PreK-12th will be scheduled to come to school one full day during the first partial week of instruction. Students who will be working from home will be encouraged to come to school on their scheduled day. All COVID protections will be in place, masks or shield must be worn, social distancing followed and thorough hand washing and disinfecting will be required.
- Bus available by request only for the first week. Call Liz at bus barn 376-2401 or cell 575-447-2010 to get pickup location and time. Teachers will contact parents to identify what day their child will come into school. Teachers will only be able to accommodate up to 5 students. During this first week teachers will do orientation activities with students to build trust, communication and camaraderie amongst the new class. Teachers will also assess student's academic levels and train students on how to work remotely from home. Teachers will compile students passwords, classroom expectations and will explain new onsite COVID safety measures for students.
- Teachers will use assessment, communication with parents, and prior teacher recommendations to identify the 5 students that will be identified to come back the following week for onsite instruction. If your child is selected to come onsite, it is highly recommended for you to consider your child's need in determining an onsite or online work platform. Parent decisions will be honored.

Who Will Come to School and When?

- Aug. 18th to 21st
- Per the Governor's order, there will be no mass attendance at school until at least September 8
- Small Group 1:5 ratio prioritized by teacher
- Fluid Groupings for first 4 weeks while teachers work to offer all students individualized support
- HYBRID LEARNING projected to start for elementary students September 8th.
- Middle School two week later
- High School two week after that estimated first week of October.

Daily Schedule

Cimarron Schools will operate on the following schedule: ALL students Tuesday-Friday, from 9:00am to 3:00pm.

The one hour delay in the morning is to accommodate the time necessary for screening of students riding the bus.

The one hour early release in the afternoon is to reduce the amount of time students are in masks, to allow for remediation and intervention for at-risk or struggling students, and to allow devoted time to check in and support students working online.

The School Day on Campus

- School day is from 9 am to 3 pm.
- There will be screening on entering the bus or the building
- Masks are required for entering the bus or the building and worn all day
- Bathroom breaks will be scheduled and the student will have the ability to identify that they need to use the bathroom outside of the scheduled time in the case of an emergency.
- Recess scheduled by teacher.

The School Day - Online

- Attendance is important and will be taken each day!
- Be online and ready to start at 8:55.
- Breaks will be determined by teacher.
- Lunch schedule will be identified.
- School ends at 3 pm unless you are needing some additional support, which happens from 3-4 pm

Health and Safety Measures

- Students and Staff will be screened daily before they are allowed to enter the school or bus or have any other initial contact with the school
- This screening will include:
 - temperature taken and recorded
 - asked about symptoms to include fever, cough, shortness of breath, abdominal pain, diarrhea, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, loss of smell or taste
- If a student does not pass the screening questionnaire or has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, or is she or she will not be allowed on the bus or at school.
- Students may have their temperature checked multiple times a day.

More Health and Safety Issues

- Bathrooms will be cleaned multiple times per day, but there is no expectation that the bathrooms will be cleaned after each use. As a group is scheduled, the teacher will disinfect the bathroom handles and sinks after the group is finished.
- Disinfectant wipes, hand soap, hand sanitizer and paper towels will be available in bathrooms for staff and students. Younger children will have adult supervision to ensure safety.
- Drinking fountains will not be in service. Teachers will monitor the filling of water bottles at filling stations

Being Sick at School

- If a student or staff member develops a fever or symptoms during the day, they will need to go home as soon as possible.
- Students will be kept in an "isolation" room until they are picked up.
- The District will work with the Colfax Hospital District and parents to try to rule out the possibility of COVID 19. If COVID 19 is suspected and can't be ruled out, students will need to quarantine for 14 days.

Meals

- REGULAR FREE/REDUCED STANDARDS
- Meals will be available on days when school is in session (Tuesday-Friday)
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided as normal on regular school days.
- Meals at school will be eaten in classrooms. Meals will be individually packaged and delivered to the classrooms.
- Meals will be available for pickup at Cimarron Campus,
 Eagle Nest Campus and Moreno Valley High School from
 11-12.
- Meal deliveries may not be available.

What We Need From YOU

- Ensure your student is registered for school as soon as possible so we can plan for them.
- When your child is not feeling well, please keep him/her home. We will need COVID test if school send child home sick with possible COVID symptoms.
- Prepare your child to wear a face covering while at school. This is a state requirement unless they have a medical exemption that requires a note from a medical provider.
- Please send a refillable water bottle for your child's use.

PED Requirements Review

- A statewide initiative will support a rapid response line to DOH, as well as contact tracing procedures, to schools with suspected and confirmed COVID case(s)
- Social Distancing practice of 6 ft will be practiced
- Large Group gatherings will be avoided. All large functions have been replaced with smaller group gatherings, or virtual events.
- Face coverings are required for all students and staff except while eating, and drinking with limited exceptions for students and staff who have medical reasons for not wearing masks.*
- Meals will be provided for all students, whether on-site or online. Students working online from home will be able to pick up breakfast and lunch at Cimarron, Eagle Nest, and Angel Fire School campuses during serving time.
