What to Expect as We Start Hybrid School PreK-12

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- **HYBRID LEARNING**
- **On-site classes 2 days a week Online classes 2 days a week. Tuesday through Friday**
- **Students who have an IEP requiring additional instructional services will be able to be on site 4 days per week.**
- **MONDAY SCHOOL FEB. 8th FOR IDENTIFIED STUDENTS ONLY**
- **Bus available daily. Please call Liz at bus barn 376-2401 or cell 575-447-2010 to get pickup location and time.** Teachers have contacted parents to identify what day their child will come into school.
- **Students and staff will be required to wear masks, social distance and maintain proper hand washing**

Daily Schedule

Cimarron Schools will operate on the following schedule:

Students will be identified for two days of instruction on site Tuesday-Friday, from 9:00am to 3:00pm.

Students will be required to participate remotely 2 days per week online with their classroom peers onsite.

Now that students are able to be onsite PreK-12, please be responsive to teachers when your child is invited to 3:00-4:00 intervention, 3:00-5:30 intervention or Monday School

Bus service will not be available for after school interventions

Daily Lunch Service for Onsite and Online Students

Week of Feb. 8th

All Students at Monday School will be fed onsite. (Identified Students Only)

Students on site will be fed at all school locations and meals can be picked up from 12-1 at 12-1 at CEMS and Eagle Nest

No delivery service next week.

Starting Monday Feb. 15th

Meal Kits will be delivered every Monday for families that are not able to pick up meals daily

Tuesdays through Fridays kids on site will be fed and pick up will be available from 12-1 at CEMS and Eagle Nest and MVHS

District Wide Remote Learning February 12 for staff vaccinations. NO MEAL SERVICE

The School Day on Campus

- School day is from 9am to 3pm.
- There will be screening before entering the bus or the building
- Masks are required for entering the bus or the building and worn all day
- Bathroom breaks will be scheduled and the student will have the ability to identify that they need to use the bathroom outside of the scheduled time in the case of an emergency.
- Recess scheduled by teacher.

The School Day - Online

- Attendance is important and will be taken each day!
- Be online and ready to start by 8:55.
- Breaks will be determined by teacher.
- Lunch schedule will be stay at the same time.
- School ends at 3 pm unless you are needing some additional support, which happens from 3-4 pm

Health and Safety Measures

- Students and Staff will be screened daily before they are allowed to enter the school or bus or have any other initial contact with the school
- This screening will include:
 - temperature taken and recorded
 - asked about symptoms to include fever, cough, shortness of breath, abdominal pain, diarrhea, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, loss of smell or taste
- If a student does not pass the screening questionnaire or has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, he or she will not be allowed on the bus or at school.
- Students may have their temperature checked multiple times a day.

More Health and Safety Issues

- Bathrooms will be cleaned multiple times per day, but there is no expectation that the bathrooms will be cleaned after each use. As a group is scheduled, the teacher will disinfect the bathroom handles and sinks after the group is finished.
- Disinfectant wipes, hand soap, hand sanitizer and paper towels will be available in bathrooms for staff and students. Younger children will have adult supervision to ensure safety.
- Drinking fountains will not be in service. Teachers will monitor the filling of water bottles at filling stations

Being Sick at School

- If a student or staff member develops a fever or symptoms during the day, they will need to go home as soon as possible.
- Students will be kept in an “isolation” room until they are picked up.
- Please be aware that while your child’s illness may not be COVID related the school must take every precaution to keep all students safe.

PED Requirements Review

- Schools in Hybrid must surveillance test at least 12.5% of staff weekly and up to 25% of staff in district is in a RED county and results are sent to the state watch list for public reporting.
- Social Distancing practice of 6 ft will be practiced
- Large Group gatherings will be avoided. All large functions have been replaced with smaller group gatherings, or virtual events.
- Face coverings are required for all students and staff except while eating, and drinking with limited exceptions for students and staff who have medical reasons for not wearing masks.*
- Meals will be provided for all students, whether on-site or online. Students working online from home will be able to pick up breakfast and lunch at Cimarron, Eagle Nest, and Angel Fire School campuses during serving time.
